Reasons to build your business in Downtown Mount Pleasant

- 1. Great Access and High Traffic Counts-Downtown Mount Pleasant is easily accessible from U.S. Highways 34 and 218/27 Avenue of the Saints. Over 13,000 vehicles travel through Downtown Mount Pleasant daily. Mount Pleasant is within a day's drive of every major market: Chicago, St. Lois, Indianapolis, Minneapolis/St. Paul, Kansas City, Des Moines and Omaha.
- 2. Pro-Business Environment-With free downtown parking, walkable streets, and continuous public investments, Downtown Mount Pleasant is great for business. Storefront and office space is available and an active Business Development Committee can provide relocation assistance.

- 3. Strong Main Street Program-Mount Pleasant became a Main Street Iowa community in 2002. Main Street is a proven downtown revitalization approach that provides for extensive grassroots business involvement in sales, promotions, business retention and broad-based community support.
- 4. Historic Central Business District-The Main Street District is home to over 120 business and features many newly renovated historic buildings. Design guidelines and a knowledgeable Design Committee help business owners make cost effective improvements. Sign and Façade grant program is available for property and business owners.

- 5. Upper Story Housing-Mount Pleasant has helped create over 54 upper story housing units since 2002. The vibrant downtown features locally independent specialty coffee shops, retail and restaurants. In 2015, 13 new businesses opened in the Main Street district.

Festival and Events Attract Tens of Thousands of Visitors Annually-Mount Pleasant has many events that attract visitors including: Midwest Old Threshers, Triple B-Pit Row Car & Bike Show, Rock Around the Block Music Series, Market on Main Farmers Market, Iowa's #1 Haunted House and Spooky Rails, Festival of Lights, and Holiday on Main.

In 2016 Main Street Iowa commissioned Downtown Professionals Network (DPN) to complete an advanced market analysis. An online survey determined that several business types would be successful in Downtown Mount Pleasant.

Brewpub-products and service offering would include unique atmosphere, diverse menu, craft beers, and great customer service. The brewpub will range between upscale and casual and appeal to patrons such as professionals transacting business in downtown Mount Pleasant and families looking for a downtown experience.
